

Undivided Worship

Scripture

- 1 "Be careful to follow these statutes and ordinances in the land that the Lord, the God of your ancestors, has given you to possess all the days you live on the earth.
- 2 Destroy completely all the places where the nations that you are driving out worship their gods—on the high mountains, on the hills, and under every green tree.
- 3 Tear down their altars, smash their sacred pillars, burn their Asherah poles, cut down the carved images of their gods, and wipe out their names from every place.
- 4 Don't worship the Lord your God this way.
- 5 Instead, turn to the place the Lord your God chooses from all your tribes to put his name for his dwelling and go there.
- 6 You are to bring there your burnt offerings and sacrifices, your tenths and personal contributions, your vow offerings and freewill offerings, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks.
- 7 You will eat there in the presence of the Lord your God and rejoice with your household in everything you do, because the Lord your God has blessed you.
- 8 "You are not to do as we are doing here today; everyone is doing whatever seems right in his own sight.
- 9 Indeed, you have not yet come into the resting place and the inheritance the Lord your God is giving you.
- 10 When you cross the Jordan and live in the land the Lord your God is giving you to inherit, and he gives you rest from all the enemies around you and you live in security,
- 11 then the Lord your God will choose the place to have his name dwell. Bring there everything I command you: your burnt offerings, sacrifices, offerings of the tenth, personal contributions, and all your choice offerings you vow to the Lord.
- 29 "When the Lord your God annihilates the nations before you, which you are entering to take possession of, and you drive them out and live in their land,
- 30 be careful not to be ensnared by their ways after they have been destroyed before you. Do not inquire about their gods, asking, 'How did these nations worship their gods? I'll also do the same.'
- 31 You must not do the same to the Lord your God, because they practice every detestable act, which the Lord hates, for their gods. They even burn their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods.
- 32 Be careful to do everything I command you; do not add anything to it or take anything away from it.

CHICKEN SOUP

Faith without works is dead.

James 2:20

"I believe some chicken soup will help Johnny get over his cold," said Grandma as she put a chicken in the pot, peeled some vegetables, and prepared the tonic. Later that afternoon, she said, "I believe those flowers need some water." She filled her watering can and gave them a good dousing. "I believe I need a good night's sleep," she said that evening and headed toward bed.

Grandma's "I believes" were all followed by activities, illustrating a vital point: we behave according to our beliefs. As James put it, "I will show you my faith by my works" (2:18). Faith leads to action, and faith in God leads to obedience. He hasn't asked us to put our trust in warm, fuzzy feelings about Him. He tells us to put our trust in the revelation He has already given—His Word. When we obey, we are exercising faith. If you want an accurate measurement of your faith, see if you're obeying God's commands.

George MacDonald once said, "You can begin at once to be a disciple of the Living One—by obeying Him in the first thing you can think of in which you are not obeying Him. We must learn to obey Him in everything, and so must begin somewhere. Let it be at once, and in the very next thing that lies at the door of our conscience."



Confronting Your Weakness

Who gave Judas the responsibility of carrying the money box? Jesus, of course. Now, ask yourself, did Jesus know that Judas was a thief when He gave him that responsibility? Certainly! That brings me to another important lesson from this story.

This is a startling revelation for many Christians, but we will always be tempted in the area of our weakness. As a matter of fact, just as Judas—the guy with the weakness for money and prestige—was given responsibility for the money box, God will give you responsibility in the area of *your* weakness.

Why? You may be thinking. *Does God set us up to fail?* No! Actually, He's setting us up to succeed. The only way we can truly succeed is by confronting our weaknesses and overcoming them.

When God gives you some small responsibility in the area of your weakness, He is taking you through a growth process necessary for your success. You see:

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able (1 Cor. 10:13).

According to the Bible, you have never experienced a temptation that you did not have the ability to resist. We always make a conscious choice to sin. However, God wants to help us turn our area of greatest potential for defeat into our area of greatest victory.

Thus, Jesus gives a thief responsibility for the money and, in doing so, gives him the opportunity to overcome his selfishness and greed. But Judas didn't do it, did he?

Money is a bigger test than you think. In fact, you are being tested by money right now. It is vital that you understand this truth: The extent of the responsibility you will have in the Kingdom is directly proportional to how you handle money.


