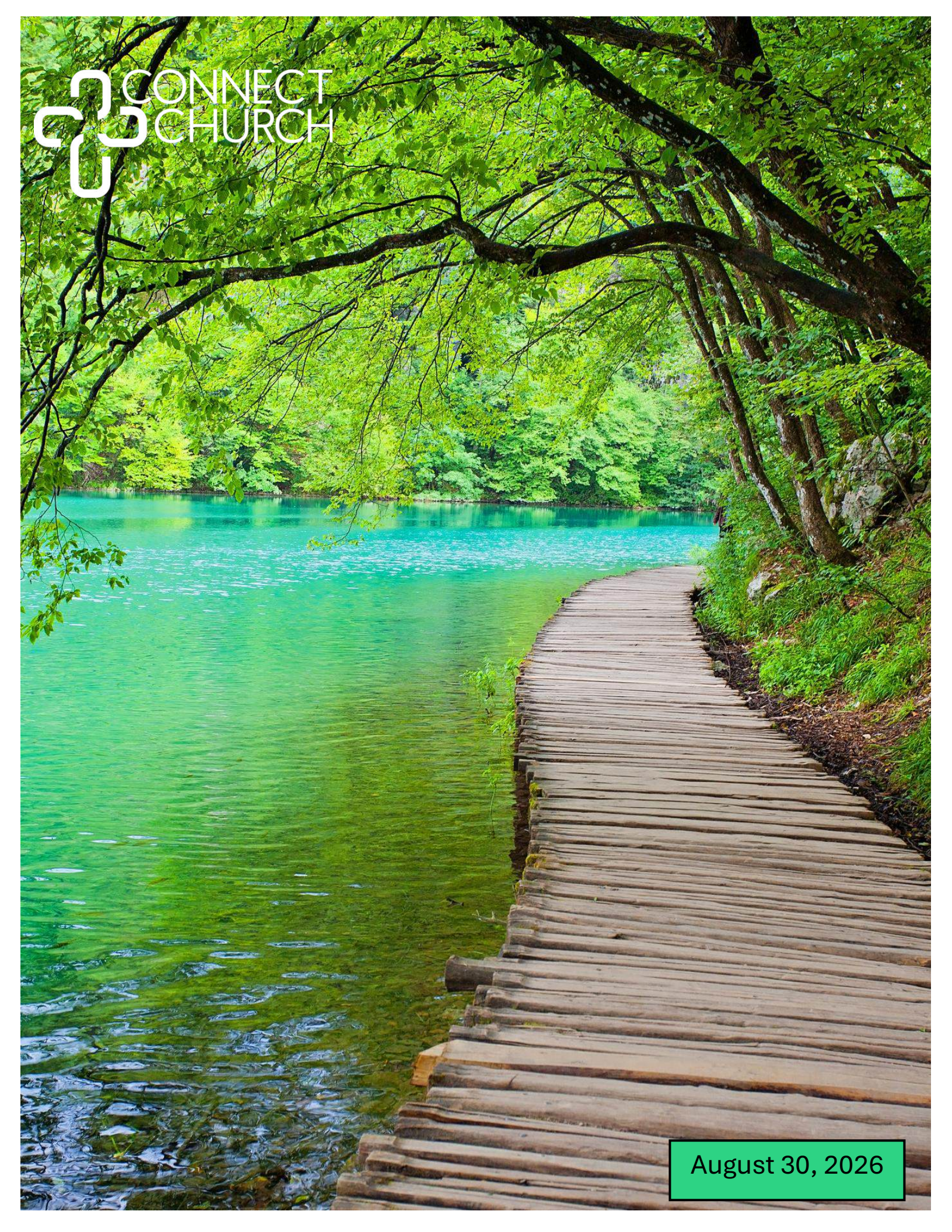

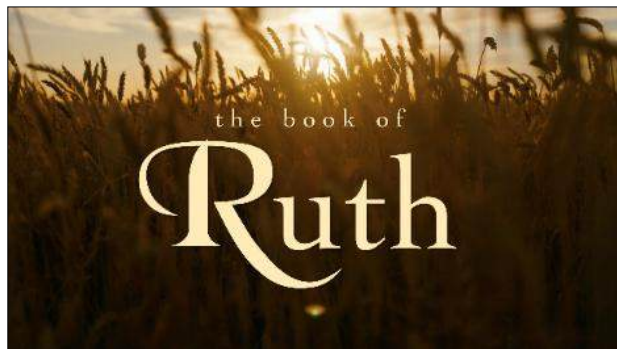


Redemption

Scripture

- 8 At midnight, Boaz was startled, turned over, and there lying at his feet was a woman!
- 9 So he asked, "Who are you?" "I am Ruth, your servant," she replied. "Take me under your wing, for you are a family redeemer."
- 10 Then he said, "May the Lord bless you, my daughter. You have shown more kindness now than before, because you have not pursued younger men, whether rich or poor.
- 11 Now don't be afraid, my daughter. I will do for you whatever you say, since all the people in my town know that you are a woman of noble character.
- 12 Yes, it is true that I am a family redeemer, but there is a redeemer closer than I am.
- 13 Stay here tonight, and in the morning, if he wants to redeem you, that's good. Let him redeem you. But if he doesn't want to redeem you, as the Lord lives, I will. Now lie down until morning."
- 13 Boaz took Ruth and she became his wife. He slept with her, and the Lord granted conception to her, and she gave birth to a son.
- 14 The women said to Naomi, "Blessed be the Lord, who has not left you without a family redeemer today. May his name become well known in Israel.
- 15 He will renew your life and sustain you in your old age. Indeed, your daughter-in-law, who loves you and is better to you than seven sons, has given birth to him."
- 16 Naomi took the child, placed him on her lap, and became a mother to him.
- 17 The neighbor women said, "A son has been born to Naomi," and they named him Obed. He was the father of Jesse, the father of David.

OUR KINSMAN-REDEEMER

(for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree").*

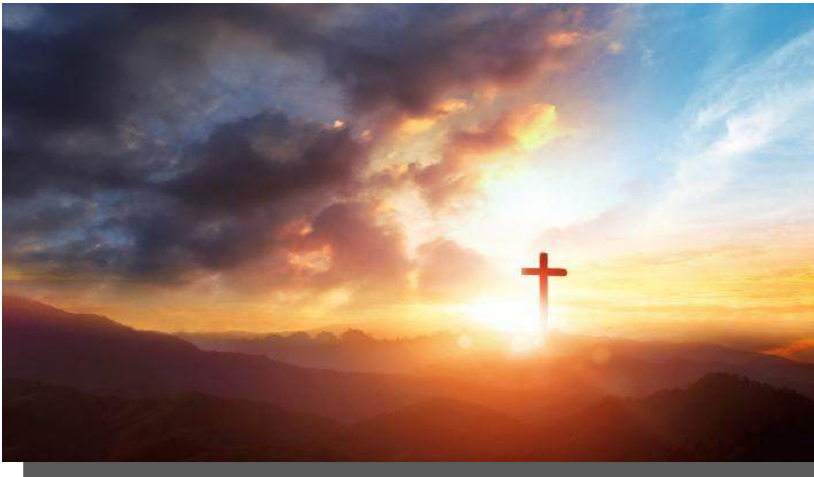
Galatians 3:13

Israel had statutes that provided for stability in society; regulation of debt, slavery, poverty, the transfer of property, and the preservation of families and clans. The story of Ruth is an example. When she found herself a young widow, one of her former husband's relatives - Boaz, known as a kinsman-redeemer—stepped in to marry her and purchase her former father-in-law's property.

When people found themselves in unfortunate circumstances, God provided a means for their care and redemption—a way to be delivered from trouble through the extended family. That provision is fully manifested in the New Testament. Christians are adopted into God's family (Romans 8:15-16), a family in which Jesus Christ is the firstborn Son (verse 29), and we are coheirs with Him of all God's promises (verse 17). When we found ourselves in trouble—guilty of sin—God sent His firstborn Son to redeem us and incorporate us into God's family. Jesus Christ is our Kinsman-Redeemer.

Thank God today that, though you were once an orphan and an outcast, you have been purchased by Christ's blood and made an heir of God.

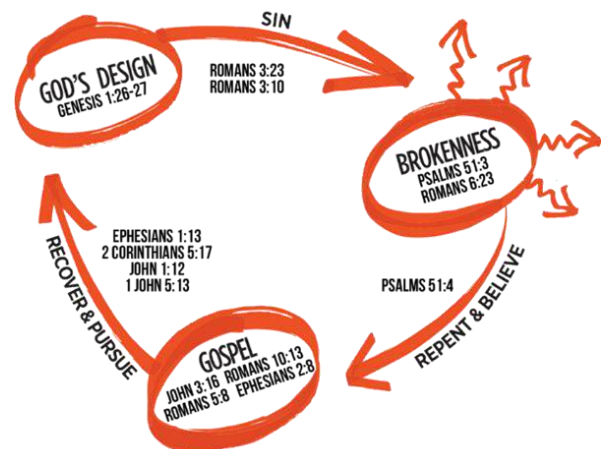

Our lives have two phases: one a dot, the other a line extending out from that dot.

Our present life on earth is the dot. It begins. It ends. It's brief. But from that dot extends a line that goes on forever. That line is eternity, which Christians will spend in heaven.

Right now we're living in the dot. But what are we living *for*? The shortsighted person lives for the dot. The person with perspective lives for the line.

This earth (and my time here) is the dot. My beloved Bridegroom, the coming wedding, the Great Reunion, and my eternal home in the New Heaven and New Earth—they're all on the line. That's our next key: *I should not live for the dot but for the line.*

The person who lives for the dot lives for treasures on earth that end up in junkyards. The person who lives for the line lives for treasures in heaven that will never end.

Giving is living for the line.

We'll each part with our money. The only question is when. We have no choice but to part with it later. But we do have a choice whether to part with it *now*. We can keep earthly treasures for the moment, and we may derive some temporary enjoyment from them. But if we give them away, we'll enjoy eternal treasures that will never be taken from us.

This is what Jim Elliot was talking about when he said, "He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose." If you hear those words and think, *Oh, he was one of those superspiritual missionary types who didn't think about gain*, then you missed the whole point. Read it again. Gain was *precisely* what Jim Elliot was thinking about! He just wanted the kind of gain he couldn't lose. He wanted his treasure in heaven.

Live for the line, not for the dot.

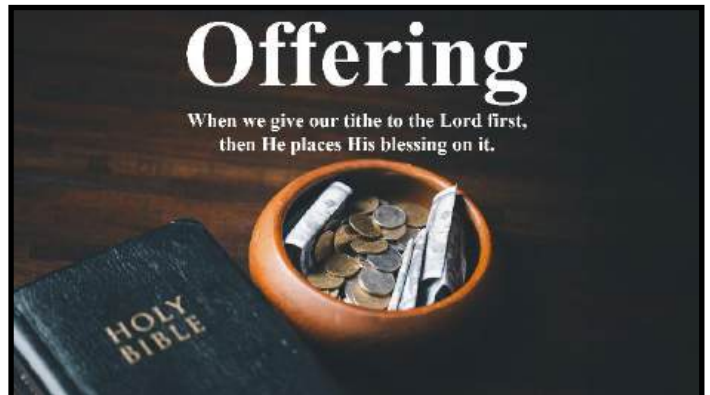

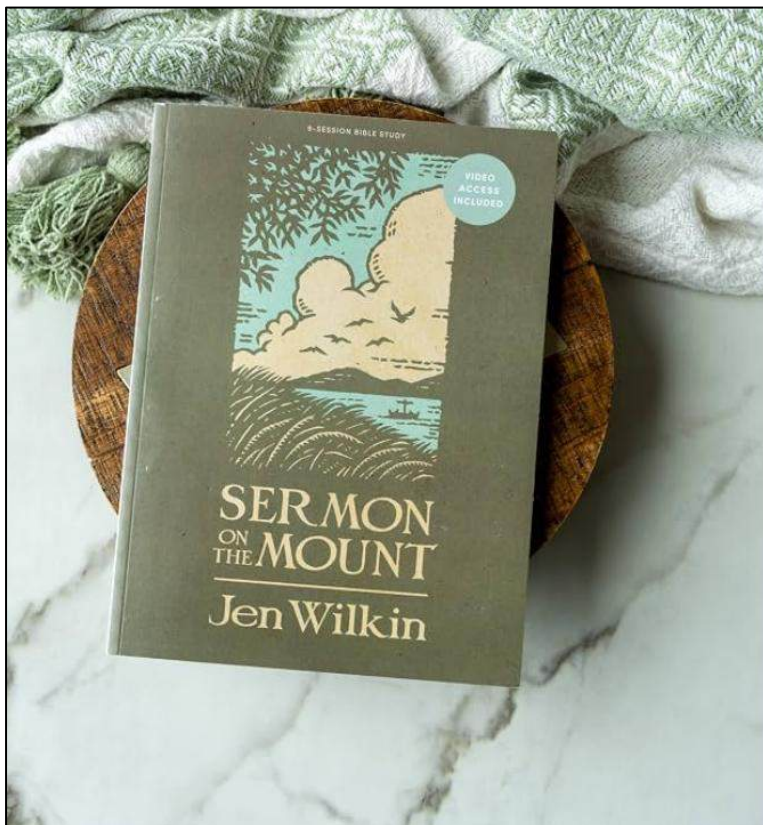
