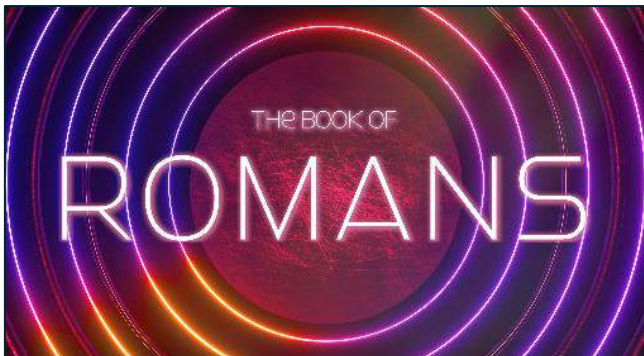


Coming Judgement

Scripture

- ¹ Therefore, every one of you who judges is without excuse. For when you judge another, you condemn yourself, since you, the judge, do the same things.
- ² Now we know that God's judgment on those who do such things is based on the truth.
- ³ Do you think—anyone of you who judges those who do such things yet do the same—that you will escape God's judgment?
- ⁴ Or do you despise the riches of his kindness, restraint, and patience, not recognizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance?
- ⁵ Because of your hardened and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath, when God's righteous judgment is revealed.
- ⁶ He will repay each one according to his works:
- ⁷ eternal life to those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor, and immortality;
- ⁸ but wrath and anger to those who are self-seeking and disobey the truth while obeying unrighteousness.
- ⁹ There will be affliction and distress for every human being who does evil, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek;
- ¹⁰ but glory, honor, and peace for everyone who does what is good, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek.
- ¹¹ For there is no favoritism with God.
- ¹² For all who sin without the law will also perish without the law, and all who sin under the law will be judged by the law.
- ¹³ For the hearers of the law are not righteous before God, but the doers of the law will be justified.

Turn It Around

The kindness of God leads you to repentance

Romans 2:4

Last week we discussed taking a step of faith. Today's focus is repentance. Repent and confess—not the most pleasant words, are they? They are associated with faults and failings we would rather forget or ignore. So how is it that Paul suggests it is God's kindness that reveals them to us?

As we saw last week, the word faith signifies agreeing with God. However, the Greek word for repent conveys the idea of turning around and going in the opposite direction. The Father realizes we'll be attracted to the solutions this world has for our problems, but He also knows that they will only make matters worse. Once we acknowledge that we've done wrong, in His goodness He turns us around, puts us on His path, and leads us to His best for us.

God's guidance is important because our human inclination when we are in a hole is to keep digging. We think if we try harder or do more of the wrong thing somehow it will become right. We realize the consequences of such behavior—we've lived them. Thankfully, Jesus saves us from all that. In His kindness, He shows us how to be different. So today, praise Him for showing you a better way. Confess, repent, and give Him the glory.

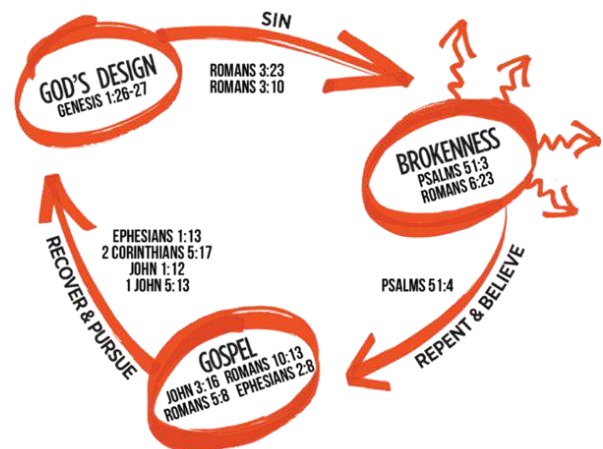

Mud Pies In The Slum

After exposing the Laodiceans' spiritual poverty hidden beneath their wealth, Jesus offered them real treasures: "I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich" (Revelation 3:18).

When Christ returns, the world "will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare" (2 Peter 3:10). Does that sound depressing? It would be depressing if this world were our home. But it isn't! It would be depressing if we couldn't use our lives and resources to make a difference for eternity. But we can!

C.S. Lewis put it this way:

We are halfhearted creatures, fooling about with drink and sex and ambition when infinite joy is offered us, like an ignorant child who wants to go on making mud pies in a slum because he cannot imagine what is meant by the offer of a holiday at sea. We are far too easily pleased.

Even many Christians have settled for a life of unsatisfying material acquisitions, like making mud pies in a slum.

There's something so much better than anything the world can offer—eternal treasures and exhilarating joy.

You want these treasures and this joy, don't you? But maybe you have some practical questions about giving, or you're not sure where to start.
